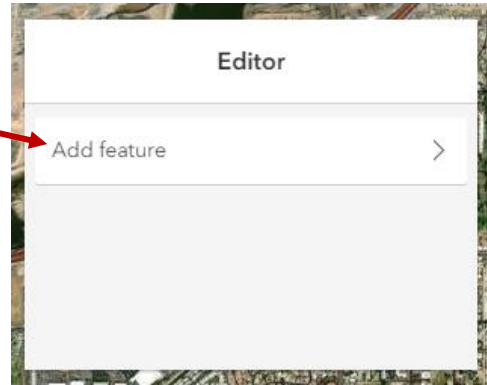


Traffic Control Plan Map Instructions

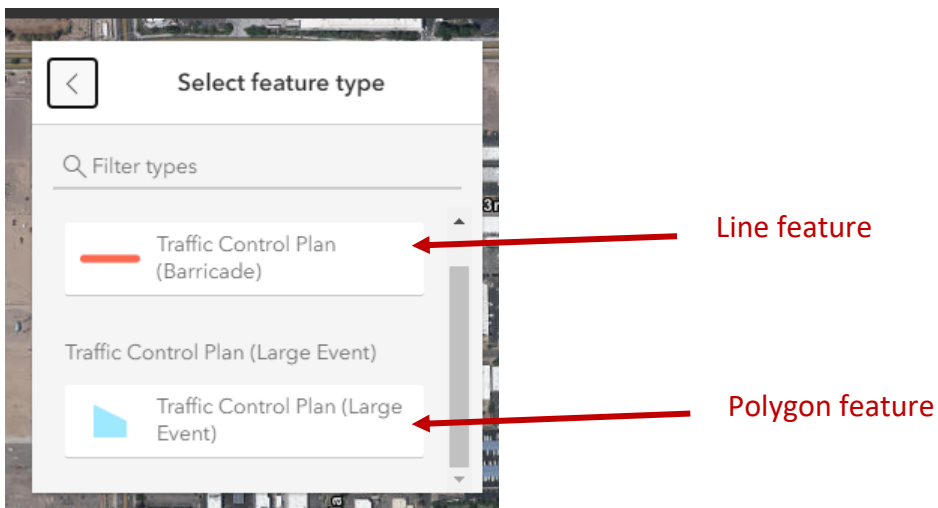
The map works best in **Chrome**. We recommend that you bookmark the map in your browser for future use.

1. Using the scroll wheel on your mouse or the plus and minus sign  on the map, zoom in to the area where the traffic control set-up will be located.

2. In the box on the right titled *Editor*, click on “Add feature.”



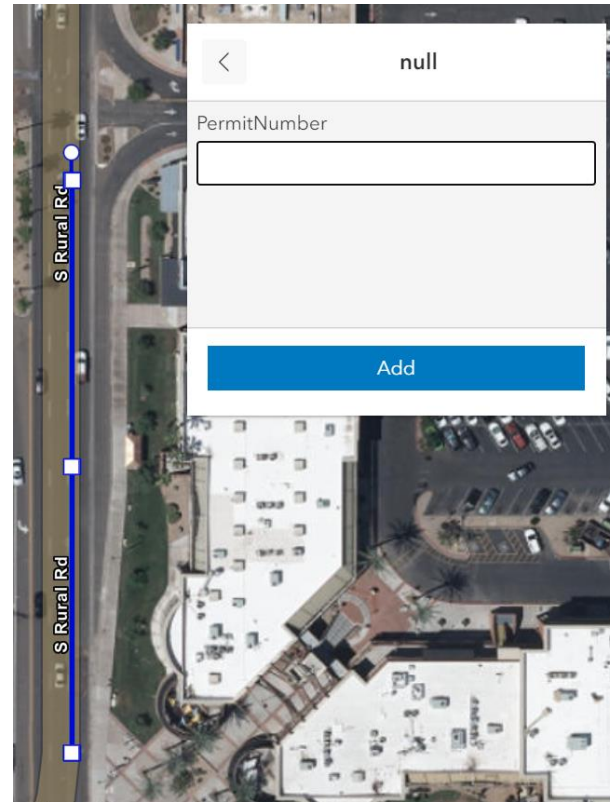
3. You have two options to draw the traffic control set-up on the map. (1) If your traffic control set-up includes 5 or fewer streets, use the line tool. (2) If your traffic control set-up includes more than 5 streets or covers a neighborhood, use the polygon (shape) tool.



- When adding a line feature, click on the location where the devices will start. Then move to the location where the devices will end and double click to complete. Please try to be as accurate as possible in identifying the area where the traffic control set-up will occur.

Enter the traffic control plan number and click “Add.” The feature that you draw will be visible for 10 minutes and then disappear.

If your traffic control set-up covers multiple roads (up to five), you will need to repeat the process above for each road. You will add the traffic control plan number for each line.



- When adding a polygon feature, start by clicking on a location that represents the corner of the traffic control set-up area boundary. Continue to click on the map to draw the boundary. To complete the area, double click on the last corner. Please try to be as accurate as possible in identifying the area where the traffic control set-up will occur.

Enter the traffic control plan number and click “Add.” The feature that you draw will be visible for 10 minutes and then disappear.
